Product Changes and Enhancements

The PrinterOn Print Delivery Station allows users to turn nearly any printer into a cloud capable printer. The PrinterOn Print Delivery Station software connects your printers or MFPs to PrinterOn's services; PrinterOn Hosted, PrinterOn Express and PrinterOn Enterprise Editions.

The PrinterOn PDS software is a software-based cloud print enabling solution that provides a wide range of options and flexibility to meet various deployment needs. The solution is simple with easy installation and configuration capabilities to enable printers and MFPs in minutes.

IMPORTANT NOTE: This update does not apply to PrinterOn Enterprise or PrinterOn Express version 3 or later. This update is intended for PrinterOn Enterprise 2.5 and PrinterOn Hosted users.

This upgrade has introduced a number of improvements including:

PrinterOn Print Delivery Station New Additions and Improvements

- **New – Remote Configuration of Print Delivery Station output destinations**
Administrators can now configure PDS IP printer destination information centrally using the PrinterOn Administrative Console. PDS receives output information during customization synchronization allowing administrators to pre-configure PDS prior to installation.
- **Improved – Significant PDS Synchronization performance improvements**
Significant improvements have been made to the PDS synchronization process. Improvements have resulted in up to a 100x improvement in synchronization performance for PDS instances with large numbers of printers.
- **Improved – User Interface Responsiveness**
Improvements have been made to the PDS configuration interface. The user interface is now more responsive particularly when modifying settings when processing jobs at the same time.
- **Fixed – Jobs fail to process when configuring printer settings**
Addressed an issue that caused PDS to stop receiving jobs for printers when the printer's settings were being modified.
NOTE: Changing settings such as the output destination of a printer while jobs are being received is not recommended in most situations. Changes can result in the output of a previously submitted print job to be delivered to the new destination.

- **Fixed – Properties File Corruption**

Addressed an issue that caused the PDS properties file to become damaged and unable to show the list of printers managed by the PDS.

System Requirements

- A dedicated physical server or virtual machine
- Intel compatible processor with 2GHz multi-core processor
- 2 GB RAM minimum (4 GB recommended)
- 2 GB of free disk space for PrinterOn Enterprise software and third party applications
- Windows Server 2008 (32-bit or 64-bit) or Windows Server 2012 (64-bit), with current patches installed
