

PrinterOn Print Delivery Station and PrintConnect Upgrade Notice

Product Changes and Enhancements

The PrinterOn Print Delivery Station allows users to turn nearly any printer into a Cloud Capable printer. The PrinterOn Print Delivery Station software or PrinterOn PrintConnect Cloud Print Appliance connects your printer or MFP to PrinterOn's services - those hosted by PrinterOn and the PrinterOn Enterprise Private Cloud solution.

The PrinterOn Print Delivery Station software is a software-based cloud print enabling solution, whereas the PrintConnect is a dedicated hardware cloud print appliance. Together, these solutions provide a wide range of options and flexibility to meet various deployment needs. Both solutions have simple and easy installation and configuration capabilities to enable printers and MFPs in minutes.

This upgrade has introduced a number of improvements including:

- **New – Push Notifications**

A new integrated push notification solution now allows client applications to be notified more quickly about the availability of print jobs. Clients including PrinterOn's Print Delivery Station, PrintConnect and the Ricoh HotSpot product lines will also be updated to leverage these new capabilities. The PrinterOn Print Delivery Station is being released alongside a Print Delivery Hub update allowing users to leverage these enhancements immediately.

- **New – Windows 8 Support**

PrinterOn's Print Delivery Station now supports Windows 8. All existing functionality and features have been migrated to the latest Microsoft platform.

- **New – Japanese Language Support**

The Print Delivery Station Release Client platform now supports Japanese in addition to the existing set of supported languages: English, French, German, Dutch, Spanish and Italian. Please note that Japanese is not supported on the PrintValet keypad due to hardware restrictions.

- **Improved – Language Selection Options**

The Print Delivery Station Release Client's language selection has been updated and is now presented using an easy to configure drop-down list. Administrators may select which languages to enable and present to users in the drop down, as well as specifying a default Release Client language.

- **Updated – Java Version**

The supplied Java version included with the Print Delivery Station has been updated to JRE 7. JRE 7 is now the default supported JRE for the Print Delivery Station software.
